- Send us your high school transcript through junior year. Transfer students must submit college transcripts. Learn more about application requirements at admissions.olemiss.edu.
- Send us your official ACT/SAT scores directly from the testing agency. Test scores are not required for transfer students who meet the transfer core curriculum.
- **Submit** the FAFSA beginning October 1.

 Mississippi residents should also apply for state aid.
- Submit the Special Programs & Scholarships Application or the Community College Transfer Scholarship Application at olemiss.edu/apply. Deadlines for scholarships and a full financial aid timeline can be found at finaid.olemiss.edu.
- Once admitted, visit olemiss.edu/newstudent for next steps pertaining to on-campus housing, orientation, and class registration.


